Title: Chore Corps Program Volunteer

# Description:

That program helped our Meals on Wheels clients who struggled with isolation, but we found that many needed practical help to be comfortable in their homes (see attached flyer). Due to age and disability many of our Meals on Wheels clients are no longer able to do every day chores like laundry or dishes. The Chore Corps Program matches clients with volunteers who can extend the time our clients can live in their homes. Below is a list of what a typical Chore Corps client looks like.

- Typically, 60 years or older
- Disabled to the point where cooking or grocery shopping is very challenging
- Live alone or there is no one to assist in daily task
- Usually referred to as "homebound"
- Living in our service area which includes Houston, Harris County and even Galveston and other surrounding areas

- Minimum 15 years old.

# What is Chore Corps?

The Chore Corps Program provides homebound clients with volunteers to help with household chores and tasks. Volunteers coordinate directly with clients, so hours are flexible and convenient.

# Who is Eligible?

All Meals on Wheels Clients:

- Homebound.
- Difficulties with everyday chores.
- Resides within Harris County, Galveston County, and other surrounding areas.

\*\*\*All volunteers must complete IMGH's volunteer orientation AND Chore Corps training to participate\*\*\*

# **Chore Corps Services:**

- <u>Lawn Care</u>: Weeding, and general upkeep of the yard. (No Mowing)
- <u>Laundry:</u> Washing, drying, folding, and putting away.
- <u>Floors:</u> Vacuuming, mopping, sweeping.
- <u>Kitchen Help:</u> Washing, drying, and putting away dishes, checking for expired products.
- <u>Friendly Visits:</u> Spending time getting to know clients in their home and have fun together.
